

## Loeffler has Lead in Georgia Special Runoff

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
TOPEKA—Republican Kelly Loeffler leads Democrat Raphael Warnock 49.5% to 45.6% with


4.9% undecided.

"This is shaping up to be a very close election where every marginal effort will make a difference," Johannes said.

Warnock has virtually maximized his Democrat base, while Loeffler has stronger support from voters who model as Independents/Moderates.

"It could come down to turnout and which campaign will have the message that persuades the 10% of Independent, Moderate voters," Johannes said.





In terms of issues, Loeffler may have an advantage. Georgia voters are not in favor of defunding the police.

On tax and economic policy, Georgia voters are opposed to Democrat agenda.

One clear example is police funding.

"Gorgia voters, like voters in many other states and regions, are not fully

embracing the Democrat platform. It is extremely possible for a voter to reject Trump and reject Democrat policy," Johannes said.
